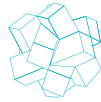


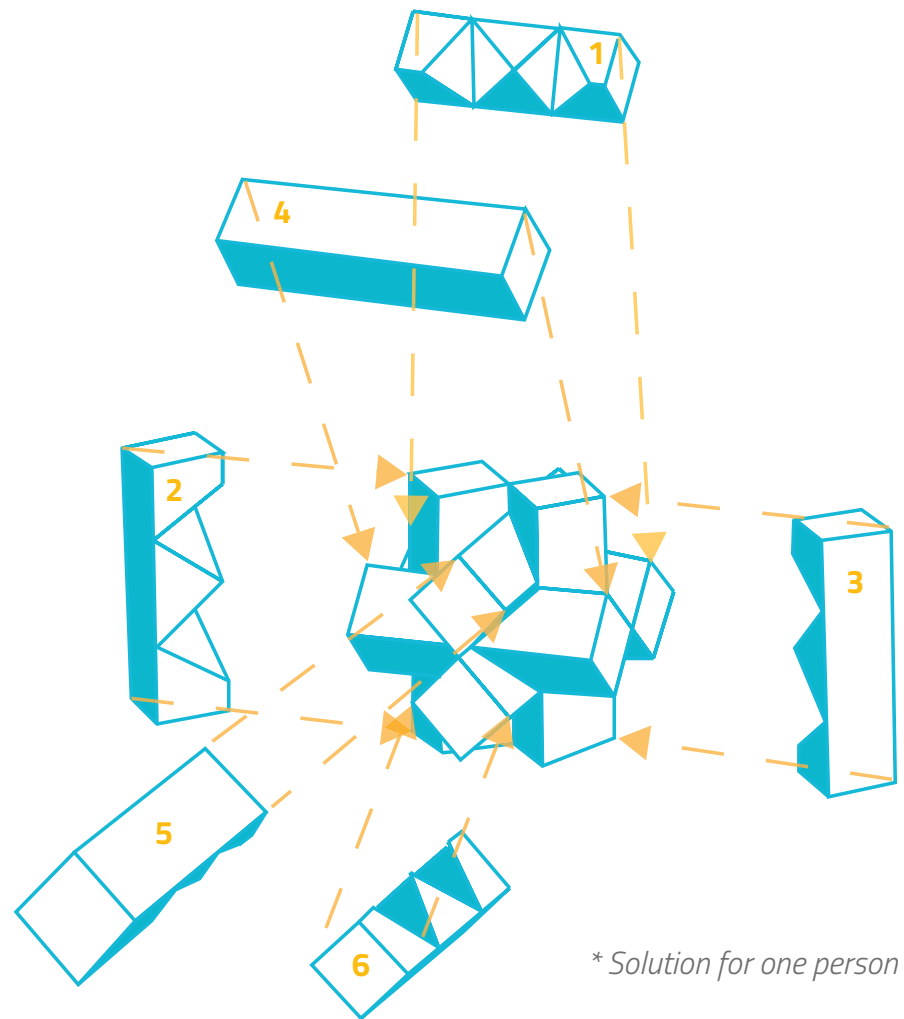
## The Gordian Knot



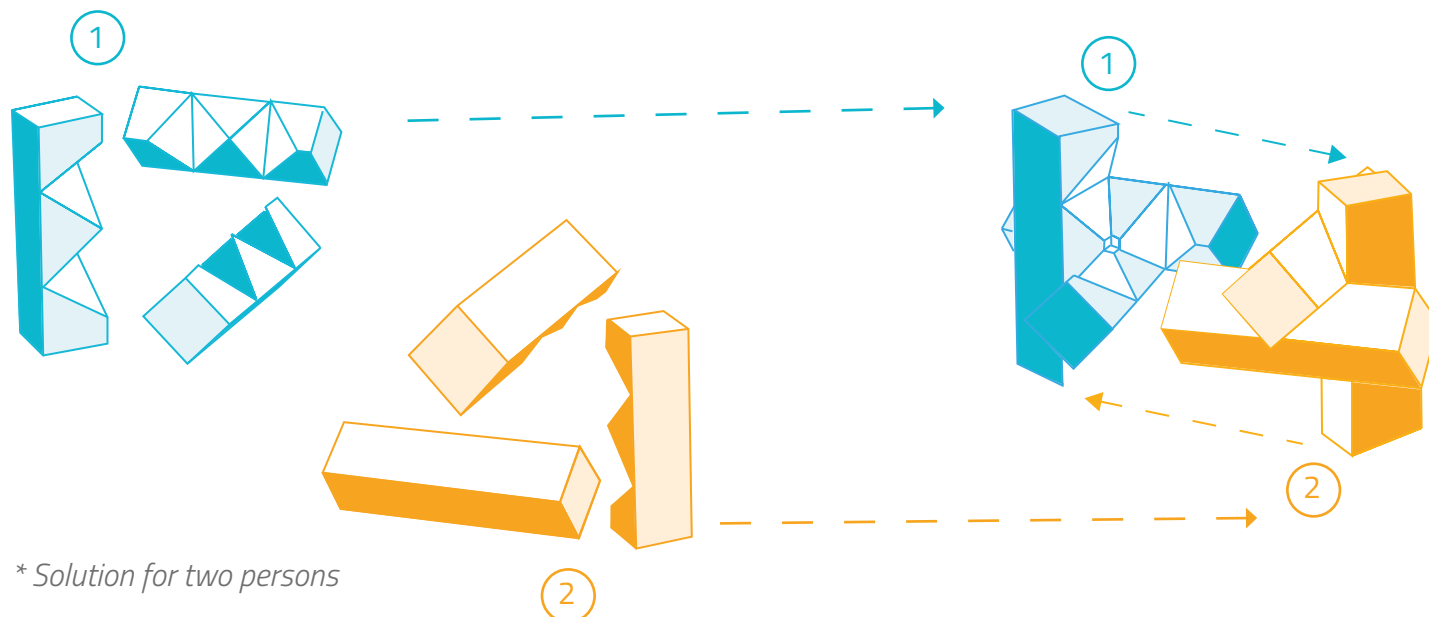
The [Gordian Knot](#) is an ancient knot famous for being impossible to untie. Solution proposed by [Alexander the Great](#), who sliced the knot in half with a stroke of his sword, was brilliant. However, if you don't have a sword, you can solve this puzzle on your own or with a friend of yours using the hints below. Your task is a bit more difficult, as you have not to untie the knot, but to make it!
